# AT THE MARKET SQUARE 

Circle for at least 8 couples

In three parts
(Men have their backs to the centre of the circle. They are facing their partner.)

## Part 1:

A1: Men fall back a double, dance forward a double, while women dance forward a double and fall back a double: Then, women fall back a double and dance forward a double, while the men dance forward a double and fall back a double.

B1: All set and turn single right, look diagonally to the left and change places with that left hand dancer (passing right shoulder), keep moving in a CW path to finish in your partner's original place.

B2: Left hand turn with partner, once and a half, look diagonally to the right and change places with the right hand diagonal (right shoulder), the men dance CW , (along the path of the large outside circle) followed by new partner to form one large circle.

A2: Join nearer hands with this new partner, men gate* the women, then women gate gate the men. This $2^{\text {nd }}$ gate is a bit faster and more than 360 degrees so the men finish with back to the centre of the circle, facing new partner.

## Part 2:

A1: Gentle siding, repeat.
B1, B2, A2 as in Part 1.

## Part 3:

A1: Arm right, arm left.
B1, B2, A2 as in Part 1.
