Two couples, facing

Part 1:

- A1: Forward a double and back, set and turn single. A2: Forward a double and back, set and turn single.
- B1: Men dance a CW gypsy about 1 ¼ times *while* women dance CW ¼ round the set; set once (turning to face CCW, pull back R shoulder). Each couple give left hand to partner, change places, then men lead chase CCW ¼ round the set.
- B2: Men dance a CCW gypsy about 1 ¼ times *while* women dance CCW ¼ round the set; set once (turning to face CW, pull back L shoulder). Each couple give right hand to partner, change places, then men lead chase CW ¼ round the set to original places.

Part 2:

- A1: Gentle siding (R) with partner, set and turn single. A2: Gentle siding (L) with partner, set and turn single.
- B1: same as Part 1.
 B2: same as Part 1.

Part 3:

- A1: Arm right with partner, set and turn single.
- A2: Arm left with partner, set and turn single.
- B1: Same as Part 1. B2: Same as Part 1.
