Duple Minor (double progression)

- A1: First couple slow cast to 2nd place, face up, 1M gates 1W half way*. First couple is facing down; 1s box the gnat.*
- A2: First couple dance up through the second couple above, cast to 2nd place. Dance right hands across with the couple below.
- B1: First corners (1M with the 2W below) set advancing, turn single to place. Second corners set advancing, turn single to place, *while* first corners dance half round the set CW, to finish in each other's place.
- B2: First corners change places (R); all change places (R) with partner. Join hands in a ring, balance in and out twice, moving 1 place CW each time (first couple has progressed another place).

There is a new first couple ready to start at the top of the set.
