Music: 100 Years of Joy

- A1: All approach partner a double (L); turn single (R) to place to flow into a CW ring half round; turn neighbour right hand half way to change places.
- A2: All approach neighbour a double (R); turn single (L) into a CCW ring half round; 2s set while the first couple dances a strong left hand turn once round flowing into
- B1: First woman with the 2s below and first man with the 2s above dance right hands across once round; first couple only dances a CW gypsy.
- B2: First woman with the 2s above and first man with the 2s below dance left hands across once round; first couple only dances a CCW gypsy.

Dance devised and music written by Elizabeth Goossen in December 2015 as the year of celebration for CDSS came to a close.

Village Green participated in the 100 years of celebration with many functions throughout 2015. The theme for our annual Christmas Dinner and Dance was "Spread the Joy" and the above dance was enjoyed during the evening.

Note: in *B1* the second couple give right hands to each other to make the hands across which is joined by the first woman above them and the first man below them.

In *B2* the second couple give each other left hands to make the hands across which is joined by the first woman below them and the first man above them

For each hands across the dancing couple should move strongly into the hands across.
