Duple minor - Improper

Music: A Triple Glaze

- A1: All turn single right, (dancing diagonally into the centre and out), flow into a clockwise ring moving one place;
Dance back to back with partner (on the side of the dance).
- A2: All turn single left, (dancing diagonally into the centre and out), flow into a counter-clockwise ring moving one place (all in original places)
left hands across once round.
- B1: First couple waltzes down the middle 2 steps, then turning toward each other (so they are facing up) continue down the middle for 2 steps; dance up the middle for 2 steps, separate to meet the 2s who have waltzed straight back for 2 steps, chased up the dance, waltzed forward 2 steps to meet 1s. The 2W and 1M turn left hand while 1W and 2M turn right hand to progressed place. (First couple will continue down to meet the couple below, while second couple continue up to meet couple above. (i.e. mirror turns with the 2s splitting the 1s)
- B2: First couple dance a mirror back to back with the new second couple. (first couple dance outside and second couple dance up the middle).
Cloverleaf turn single (women right, men left) and set (not advancing)
