

JUBILEE STRAIGHTAWAY

Contra, improper
(double progression)

- A1: Actives dance down the middle and up; finish in top place facing out.
- A2: Double half figure of eight, 1s cast to begin, 2s cross up to begin (1s finish facing down, 2s facing up.) First couple change places with the 2s (left on the men's side, right on the women's side) Meet the NEXT and, giving left hands, balance once.
- B1: Ladies Chain across; lines forward and back.
- B2: Circle left to progressed places ($\frac{3}{4}$ round) and swing partner. (Actives finish in the centre facing down, gent has partner on his right. 2s finish on own side in progressed places.)
