Duple Minor Improper as of **October 2015**

- A1: Full siding with neighbour, circle left half round; turn single left.
- A2: Full siding with partner, circle left half round, turn single left.
- B1: All step back, together, dance forward and change places with partner; women change places; men change places.
- B2: First couple dances right hands across with couple above and flow into left hands across with couple below.

March 2008 The original 'Stars in the Heavens' (published April 2007) was not written the way I intended. In A1 and A2, the intention was to approach right shoulders and approach left shoulders rather than side. After discovering this error, I also decided that the tune and the dance didn't work well together and so I have devised the dance above for the tune 'Stars in the Heavens'.
