- A2: First corners set (not advancing), change places (L), left shoulder back to back with neighbour on the side of the dance.
- **B1:** First woman, followed by her partner, dances behind 2W and across the set to original place (2s dance down); right hands across half way and all turn single left.
- **B2:** Second man, followed by his partner, dances behind 1W and across the set to 2nd place improper (1s dance up); left hands across half way and all turn single right
